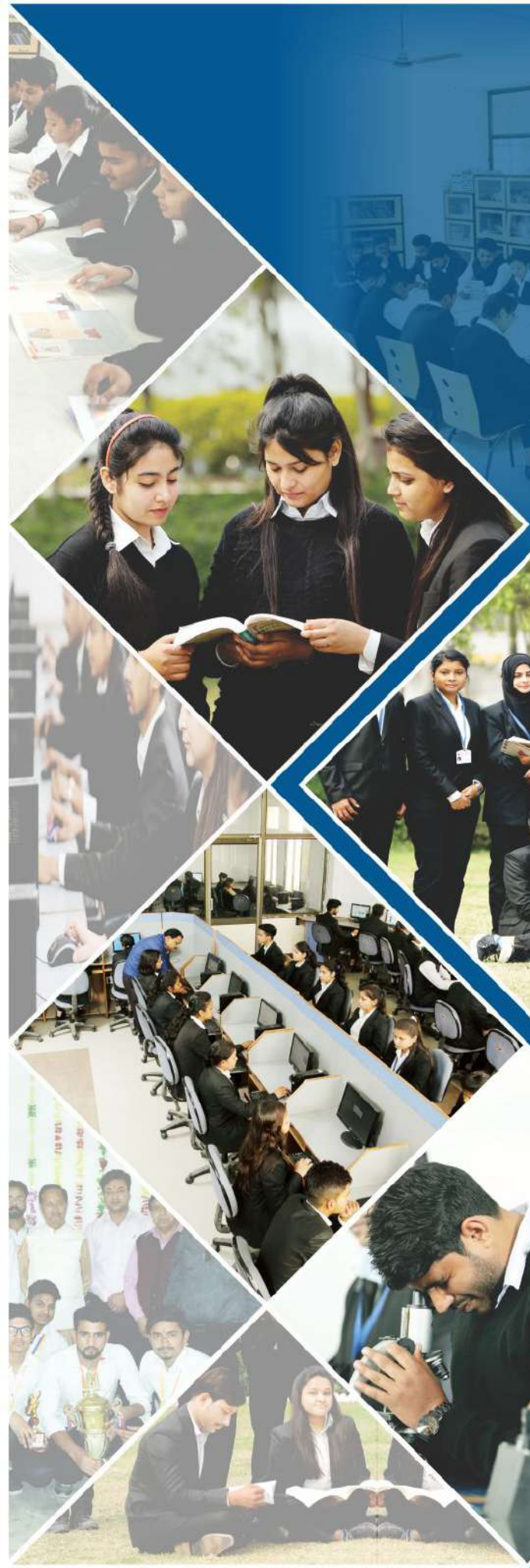

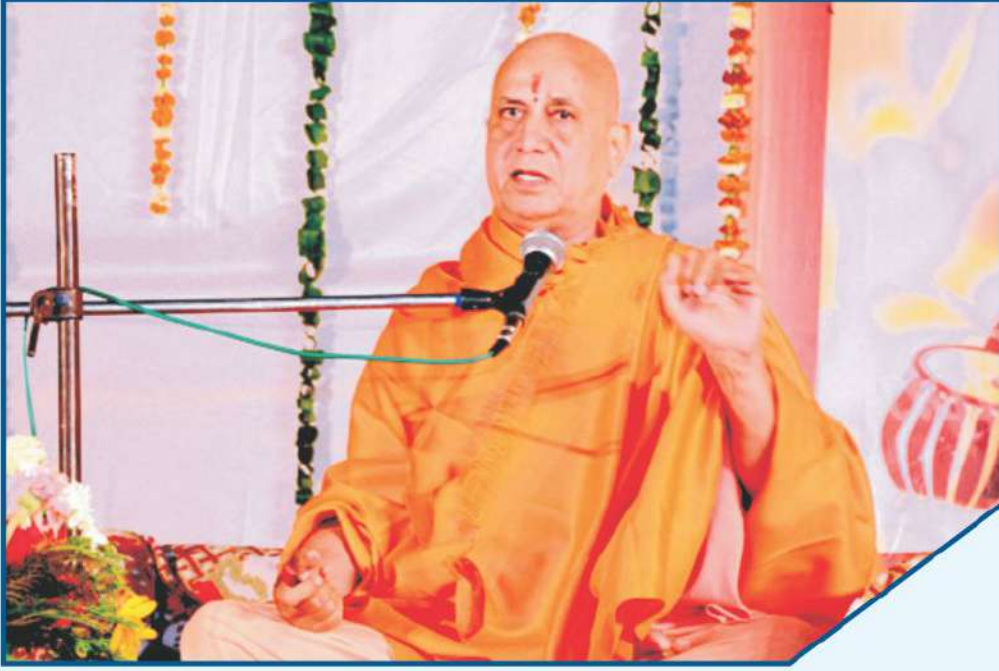

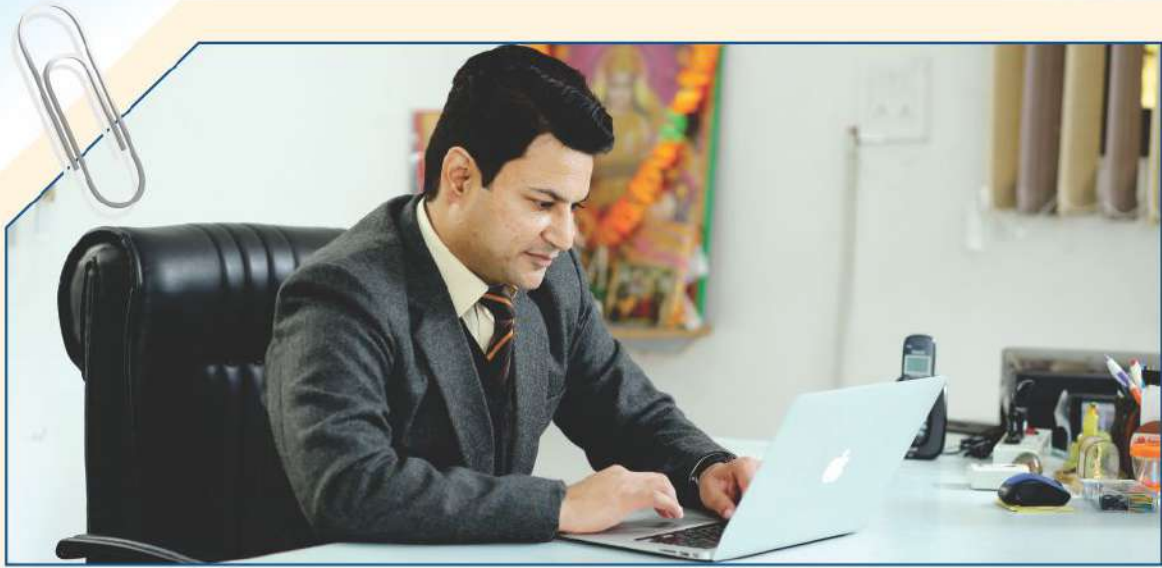

We are strongly committed to delivering quality and excellence.

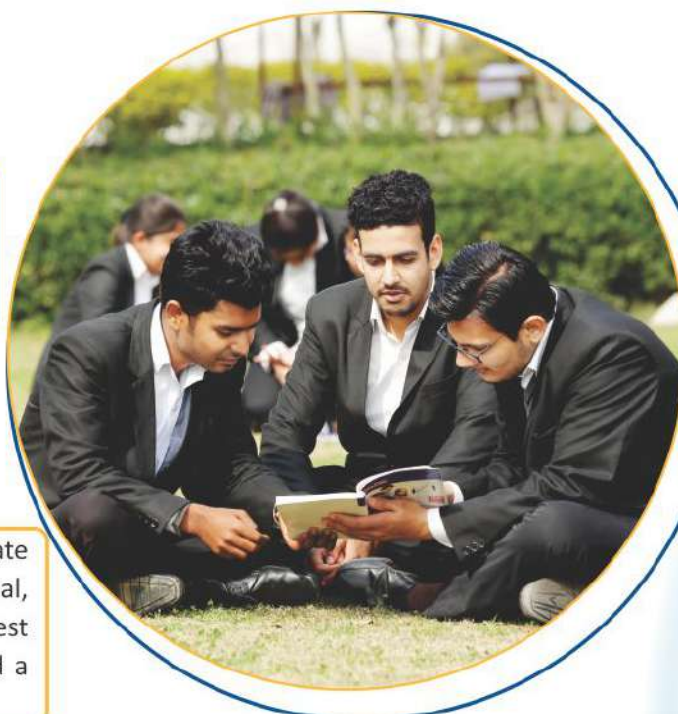

The College provides pick and drop facilities from specified locations in Saharanpur and near by location. Transport facility is available to and fro from the college gate.



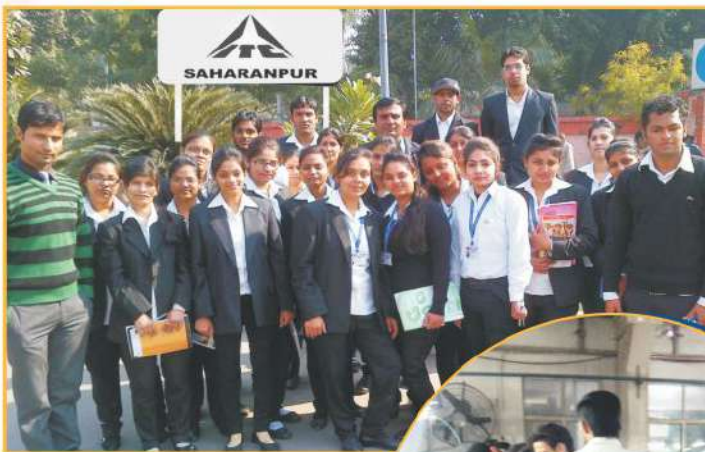

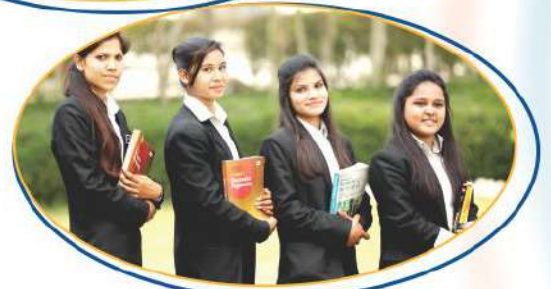

7. Any political or immoral activity is strictly prohibited in or around the College premises.
8. The College students, while parking their bikes/motor cars, are required to put proper lock on them. College administration shall not be responsible for any loss on this account, whatsoever.
9. Students are not permitted to possess or use Mobile Phones inside the college campus.
10. Browsing is not allowed during lab. hours. Students are not allowed to misuse the internet facilities.
11. No one will be allowed to listen to Music from any device inside the college campus.
12. Ragging, consuming alcohol, chewing gutka/paan and smoking are strictly prohibited in the college campus.
13. No function shall be arranged by the students in the college campus without prior permission from the Principal/Director.
14. Writing on walls, pillars, bath rooms, furniture, or black/white boards is strictly prohibited.
15. Eating snacks / taking lunch inside the class rooms or along corridors are not permitted.
16. The cost of any damage, if caused to college property will be charged to the accounts of the students responsible for the damage in addition to disciplinary action.
17. Students are advised to switch off fans and lights when they leave the class rooms.
18. Furniture in the class rooms should not be moved or displaced.
19. Students are not allowed to attend classes or any college function wearing shorts, jeans or T-Shirts.
20. No one will be allowed to whistle, hoot, shout or sing aloud while travelling in the college bus. They are also not allowed to throw papers or other articles while travelling.
21. No students shall remain in the canteen during class - hours.

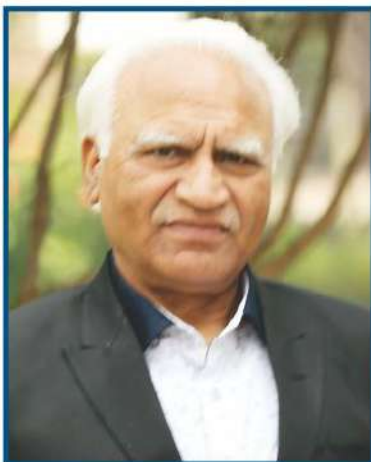
